## **Procurement – Terms & Conditions**

## Standard Contractual Provisions for Purchase Orders and Federally Funded Procurements:

Vendors accepting purchase orders or entering into a contractual agreement with LCTA for the provision of goods and services agree to comply with the terms and conditions as set forth herein and in compliance with Federal, State and Local Laws in performing its duties under this order. In addition, vendors filling an order funded by federal grant funds in whole or in part agree to comply with the applicable federal provisions. (Federal Transit Administration Clauses: Certain FTA Third-Party Contract Clauses apply to all purchases exceeding \$3,000)

In accordance with LCTA policy and compliance with the federal regulations, the Standard Federal Requirements apply to purchase orders, contracts, and procurements that do not exceed \$100,000 funded in whole or in part with federal funds.
